



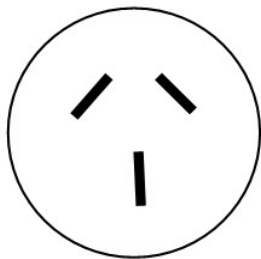
GULF HARBOUR MARINA

POWER CONNECTIONS

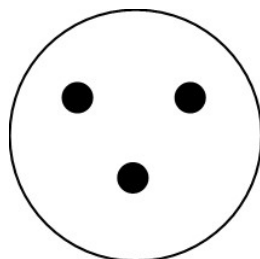
CASUAL USE: Flat Pin, 3 Pin, 10 Amp outlets are supplied on the main marina. These are for **casual use only**. ie approved power tools & appliances. The plug required for this outlet is a PDL 56 P310 or similar. These are not suitable for shorepower.

SHOREPOWER: Round Pin, 3 Pin, 16 Amp outlets are available on some berths. Please check with Berth Administration in the Main Office regarding availability.

The requirements for using Shorepower on the Marina are a current electrical WOF and the correct waterproof plug. For assistance for your electrical WOF, please contact either of our dockmasters.

CONDITIONS OF USE: CASUAL & SHOREPOWER CONNECTIONS

For both casual and shorepower connections, please ensure that the following conditions are met to ensure compliance with the Electrical Regulations 1997 and Marina Bylaws.

- The supply lead must be one of continuous length (not exceeding 20m).
- The lead shall be appropriately rated for the demand put on it by the appliance.
- The lead shall be heavy-duty rubber sheathed with all conductors including the protective earthing conductors integral within the sheathing.
- Cables are to be laid in such a manner that they are prevented from being:
 - Damaged due to friction
 - A tripping hazard to people accessing the pier.
- The supply lead shall be arranged to
 - Minimise the possibility of accidental disconnection (the cable shall be restrained at both ends).
 - To allow normal movement of the vessel without stress on the power lead
 - Prevent water from flowing along the lead to appliance inlet
 - Ensure lead and appliance can not fall into the water

Failure to comply will result in your power being disconnected.
